Homepage

1. Login box.

Although anyone can search, browse, and view abstracts, registering as a Wiley user allows you to save titles and searches, and set up email alerts.

2. If you are not registered and would like to, click here.

3. Athens, Shibboleth and Institutional login.


4. Search area.

Run a simple search directly from the homepage, or go to the Advanced or Saved search pages.

5. Browse publications alphabetically.

6. Browse by subject.

7. Access resources such as pricing, author services, training and user guides.

> Results lists and access icons

Search and browse results lists have several functions and filter options available.

1. Sort results.
2. Edit search query.
3. Save search to your profile.
4. Filter by publication type.

5. Select one or more *search* results to save to your profile or export citations (Plain Text/EndNote/Reference Manager/RefWorks).
6. Padlock icons indicate type of access available for an article or chapter:



> Articles and chapters

Journal Articles and Book Chapters have a similar layout and tool functionality.

1. Menu provides quick access to journal/book tools.
2. Access publication homepage for more details on journal, book or reference work.
3. Browse issues, articles, chapters, Table of Contents.
4. Subscribe or renew access.
5. Author, journal or book information, and special features section (if applicable).
6. Link to volume/issue or book Table of Contents page.
7. Expand to view citation, author, publication and funding information.
8. Access icon—indicates if you have access to the full text of the article or chapter.
9. Publication specific search features.
10. Article or chapter tools.
11. View abstract/summary, full text, figures, references, tables, supporting information and citations.
12. Links to related content.
